How to use Brightspace, NEWWA's new online learning platform

For online and hybrid courses, NEWWA uses the online learning platform Brightspace. Please review the instructions on how to use Brightspace, NEWWA's new online learning platform, before your first course.

How it works:

Register for an Online Class:


If you are interested in taking an online course with NEWWA, you will register online at https://newwa.org/ by logging into your NEWWA account and selecting the class you wish to take. Shortly after registering, you will receive a confirmation email that includes a link to create a Brightspace account and access your online course.

If this is your first time accessing Brightspace and you cannot find your confirmation email:

Go to www.newwa.org

Hover over Login at the top right of the page

Select Online Learning Portal



Enter in your username. This can be found in the enrollment email that was sent to you when you registered for the class. If you cannot find this email, try the same email address you use when logging into newwa.org or call a staff member at (508) 893-7979.

Create a password by clicking "Forgot your password?". Enter in your username on the next page. A password reset link will be sent to your email.

Once you have created your password, return to the login page & enter in your credentials to log in to the site.

If you have used Brightspace before:

Go to www.newwa.org

Hover over Login at the top right of the page

Select Online Learning Portal

Enter your username and password. Your new class will be visible on the Homepage.

If you have forgotten your password, click "Forgot your password?" and follow the procedure above.


Once you have logged in: Procedure for 1 - day course



 - o You will have until midnight the day of the class to complete the evaluation


Once you have logged in: Procedure for Multi-Week Courses
