



### ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Abstracts are solicited from students (undergraduate and graduate) on topics directly related to the water profession. Abstracts must be submitted electronically with ‘**NEWWA Student Poster Abstract 2026**’ in the subject line to [Dr. Kenneth Lee at leeky@farmingdale.edu](mailto:Dr. Kenneth Lee at leeky@farmingdale.edu) by the deadline. Abstracts received after the deadline will only be considered if space is available.

**Abstract Format:** Abstracts must be prepared in MS Word or PDF format, and include the following:

- Name & University of individual to present poster
- Current student status of presenter (undergraduate, M.S., or Ph.D.)
- Full contact information for presenter (address, phone, email)
- Name(s), title(s), and organizational affiliation(s) of all co-authors – Maximum 5 authors per poster
- Title
- Abstract of no more than 250 words (including a statement of the objectives, brief description of methods, principal results, and conclusions).



**Selection:** The Student Activities Committee will review abstracts and notify submitters by March 13, 2026.

**Poster Presentation:** Posters will be presented on **Wednesday, April 1, 2026**. Posters are displayed from 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., and authors are present at their posters for discussion and answering questions from 12:30 – 2:00 p.m.
